with Disability** organised at Shri  
Ashrivad Viklang Center, Sayla on  
2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 12

Students and Faculty of School of Physiotherapy, RK University, Rajkot ([www.rku.ac.in](http://www.rku.ac.in)) participated and celebrated international day for person with disability (3<sup>rd</sup> December, 11) in advance with **Disability Support Physiotherapy Camp** organized by Lions Club of Tardev, Mumbai and Shri Raj Subhag Ashrum, Sayla at **Shri Ashrivad Viklang Center, Sayla, Surendranagar, Gujarat** on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 12.



In divine presence of Shri BhaiShri, and eminent physiotherapist Dr. Saroj Sanghavi, Mumbai Physiotherapy camp was inaugurated at Shri Ashrivad Viklang Center, Sayla.

More than 600 patients from Chotila to Limdi (65) districts were participated in the camp and availed the free physiotherapy consultation, diagnosis, and treatment. The most of peoples who have participated in the camp with physical and functional disability (FD) were associated with musculoskeletal (mainly degenerative joint disorders) and neuromuscular diseases & disorders.



Patients with moderate to severe disability were provided free orthosis to improve activities of daily livings (ADLs). Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation was aimed to improve Quality of Care (QOC) and Quality of Life (QOL) of patients who are abundantly lacking with Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR).



Counseling session was mainly emphasized on health education, hygiene and ergonomic advises besides life style modification for every patient. Students had also provided treatment program for needy patients at Physiotherapy Department of Ashrivad Viklang Centre, Sayla.



Students had an opportunity to get trained and learn the principles of management of disables during the camp and fruitful interaction with Dr. Saroj Madam and Mr. Jadavbhai, Director, Ashrivad Viklang Centre, Sayla.



School of Physiotherapy had privileged from Lions Club of Tardev, Mumbai and Shri Raj Subhag Ashrum, Sayla for extending an opportunity for students to serve physical Disable for humanity.
